Silver Bullets Captures Menifee Senior Softball Championship Crown

Silver Bullets, the Menifee Valley Upper Division Senior Softball (MVUDSS) Fall 2012 champions, repeated as the Spring 2013 champions with an impressive 14-2 overall record that included two 7-game winning streaks. Second place went to the Dead Red team.

MVUDSS league games are played on Monday mornings at the Big League Dreams Sports Park in Perris. Tournament-caliber players 55 years of age and older or turning 55 in 2014 are eligible to play in the upcoming Fall 2013 Season. The league offers upper division senior softball players an opportunity to participate in a highly competitive, well-balanced, tournament-style league.

The Spring 2013 league consisted of players and teams from the Temecula Valley, Ontario, and North San Diego County areas. Traveling teams have the option of playing once a week or playing bi-weekly doubleheaders.

League President Steve Baranick said, "Our league is in its third year of operation. We now have seven teams with highly skilled senior softball players and because of the reputation we've gained in a short period of time regarding our level of play, we continue to attract new players from around Southern California. This season we added two more teams including an entirely new team from the Ontario area, Brandon's Diner. Game competition, on a week to week basis, remains at the highest level."
